ALLOCATION OF QUALIFICATION SLOTS

The qualification slot is allocated to the individual athlete, not to the NPC.

MAXIMUM QUOTA ALLOCATION PER NPC

An NPC may be allocated a maximum of three (3) qualification slots per gender per class and a maximum of thirty-three (33) male slots and thirty (30) female slots.

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for selection by an NPC, athletes must:

- meet the requirements of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF) Tournament Credit System in effect for the qualification period (1 January 2023 to 31 March 2024). This requirement does not apply to:
 - Athletes qualified via the World Qualification Tournament, and
 - Athletes selected by the Bipartite Commission.
- be ranked on the ITTF Para Table Tennis Ranking List of 1 April 2024
- be internationally classified with a 'Confirmed' sport class status or a 'Fixed Review Date' sport class status with a review date after 31 December 2024.

TOURNAMENT CREDIT SYSTEM

Players are required to participate in a minimum number of events in the qualification period depending on the continent their NPC belongs to:

- Players from Africa, Americas, and Oceania: 2 events
- Players from Asia: 3 events
- Players from Europe: 4 events

Participation in the tournament will be counted independently by event:

- To obtain a slot through one of the single slot allocation methods, only participation in the single events will count.
- To obtain a slot through the doubles slot allocation method, only participation in the doubles events will count.

MAXIMUM ENTRY PER NPC

An NPC can enter a maximum of two (2) eligible athletes per singles event.

An NPC can enter a maximum of two (2) eligible pairs per doubles event and two (2) eligible pairs per mixed doubles event, formed by two (2) eligible athletes who may also be entered in the singles events up to the limit of two (2) athletes per singles event.

QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

The order of priority to assign the qualification slots will be the following:

1. VIRTUS Global Games (class 11 only)
2. Regional Championships
3. Individual World Ranking
4. Doubles World Ranking
5. World Qualification Tournament
6. Bipartite Invitations

CONFIRMATION PROCESS OF ALLOCATED SLOTS

By 15 April 2024 and 3 June 2024 respectively each NPC must confirm to ITTF in writing (email is accepted) the number of qualification slots for selected players which they will use. NPCs that have not replied by these dates will have lost their qualification slots, and the ITTF may reallocate these slots.

By 5 June 2024 ITTF will confirm in writing the reallocation of all unused qualification slots.

By 1 July 2024 it is officially declared that the respective NPCs will use the allocated slots for the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games. Any NPC that does not use its allocated slots may be subject to sanctions by IPC and ITTF.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION SLOTS

Any qualification slots that are not used by the respective NPC will be reallocated as follows:

Slots allocated at the 2023 VIRTUS Global Games, 2023 ITTF PTT Regional Championships or the World Qualification Tournament

Any qualification slots obtained through the individual qualification method and not used by the respective NPC will be reallocated to the next highest ranked athlete(s) from that respective competition (not otherwise qualified). If no eligible athlete is available, the slot(s) will be reallocated to the next highest ranked athlete(s) on the ITTF PTT Ranking List of 1 April 2024.

Slots allocated through the ITTF PTT Singles Ranking List Allocation Method

Any qualification slots that are not used by an NPC will be reallocated by the ITTF to the next highest ranked athlete on the ITTF PTT Male and Female Singles Ranking Lists of 1 April 2024.

Slots allocated through the ITTF PTT Doubles Ranking List Allocation Method

Any qualification slots that are not used by an NPC will be reallocated by the ITTF to the next highest ranked athlete on the ITTF PTT Male and Female Doubles Ranking Lists of 1 April 2024. If no eligible athlete is available, the slot(s) will be reallocated via the Bipartite Commission Invitation Allocation method.

TIE SOLVING METHOD FOR RANKING SLOTS

Qualification by Ranking will be taken from the ITTF Para Table Tennis Ranking Lists of 1 April 2024. If two or more players or pairs have the same ranking position, ties shall be broken as follows for qualification purposes:

- The ranking positions of the players or pairs in previous months until the tie is broken;
- If there is still a tie, the player or pair with more victories in the qualification period;
- If there is still a tie, the qualification slot will be decided by lot.

APPLICATION FOR DOUBLES SLOTS

An athlete can obtain a qualification slot through the men's doubles ranking or women's doubles ranking (mixed doubles ranking is not considered). Any player qualified through a doubles ranking will be allowed to play singles and vice versa.

Allocation of a qualification slot through the ITTF PTT Doubles Ranking List Allocation method as well as subsequent entry into a doubles event require an application from the players' NPC. The application period will go from 1 January 2024 until 31 May 2024.

The application must include the names of both players who will form a pair and the doubles event that they will enter. Entry permission by ITTF will be decided based on the sum of rating points of both members of the pair. No player will receive a qualification slot through the ITTF PTT Doubles Ranking List Allocation method if he or she does not have a partner designated by their NPC.

For each athlete, there is one preferred doubles event that the athlete may enter based on the athlete's sport class. The table of priorities is the following:

Doubles entries shall be awarded to players who intend to enter in the prioritised event. If there are not enough applications for a particular prioritised event, the doubles entries shall be awarded to players who have applied to enter other events.
