Each MA may enter:

Up to 3 players per class per gender per Association. No additional entry shall be allowed to enter after the final entry deadline.

CANCELATIONS OF ENTRIES

Any cancelation received after the final entries' deadline must be made through a request using the EMS.

PLAYER ENTRY RESTRICTION

Maximum 400 players





If the maximum number of players is reached after the first entry, a limit of players per Member Association will be applied to guarantee the participation of the maximum number of countries.

14. VISA APPLICATION Member Associations must submit all necessary information to the LOC using the EMS for the invitation letter to be issued. Request of invitation letters by email will be discarded.

21. DRAWS

The draws will be conducted based on the latest ITTF World Para Ranking week 41

22. TEAM MANAGERS. MEETING & DRAW

The draw for the event will take place on 12th October 2025 and the technical meeting and draw for the event will take place on 13th October 2025 at 16:00 on the official hotel.

23. MATCH OFFICIALS

All matches will be officiated by qualified umpires in accordance with the Directives for Match Officials at World Title Competitions.

24. OBLIGATIONS

The entry will contain a statement that players nominated are willing to compete against any other participating player or team and that the participants respect and acknowledge regulations and rules of the ITTF Handbook. This statement must be confirmed by a responsible official of the nominating Member Association, and no entry form will be accepted unless such an undertaking has been given.



25. LIABILITY

A. By entering the event, participants agree to abide by all ITTF rules and by the rules and regulations of the LOC. All entered associations, and players agree to be under the auspices of the ITTF and its agents in all matters concerning television coverage, video, internet web casting, motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. Participants release all rights, or rights held by their agents or sponsors, in all matters relating to television and web casting coverage, video and motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind; and hence accept such coverage during the event. A participant's refusal of above listed coverage may be subject to suspension or dismissal from the competition. Any participant, when called upon, must appear promptly to press conferences, or medal presentations and follow the procedures set by the ITTF and the LOC.

B. By entering the event, each association must ensure that all delegation members confirm that they know that their personal data will be shared with the LOC and ITTF who, in turn, undertake not to share it with any unauthorized person in any way.

C. In the context of betting, participants in the event shall follow the ITTF Code of Ethics (Chapter 6 of the ITTF Handbook). They shall not, by any manner whatsoever, infringe the principle of fair play, show unsporting conduct, or attempt to influence the course or result of a competition, or any part thereof, in a manner contrary to sporting ethics. Any violation of this principle shall be disciplined according to provisions of ITTF regulation 3.5.3.

D. By entering the event, all delegation members undertake to abide by the ITTF's anti-doping rules in effect (Chapter 5 of the ITTF Handbook).

E. By entering the event, all delegation members undertake to abide by the Code of Ethics and ITTF Anti-Harassment Policy and Procedures (Chapter 6 & 7 of the ITTF Handbook).
